- Registration is done online on the Training page of our website. Go to www.tenring.org/Training.html and click the “Register” button on the left side of the page.
- The form needs to be filled-in, the “email” and “Phone” fields are required because we need to contact you. Remember you will **NOT** be registered until we receive your deposit and you receive a conformation from us.

NOTES:

- Due to training space the number of course participants may be limited, so please register early. To secure a space we must receive your registration form and deposit before the stated date, **NO ONE** will be accepted after this registration deadline
- **By law we must have assurance that you are not a person restricted from handling firearms. This can be done by providing us with a copy of either a Minnesota “Permit to Purchase” or “Carry Permit”, issued to you. If you have neither, a “Permit to Purchase” may be obtained at NO fee from your local police department. But please allow them two full weeks for processing.**
- To qualify as an NRA instructor, you must:
 - ◆ Possess and demonstrate a solid background in firearm safety and shooting skills. These can be acquired through previous firearms training and/or previous shooting experience.
 - ◆ Successfully complete the appropriate NRA Instructor Course and examination.
 - ◆ Receive the endorsement of the NRA Training Counselor conducting your training.
 - ◆ Submit to the NRA your application with appropriate certification and processing fee.
- Already a current NRA Instructor? Contact us as there are special requirements.
- **There is a pre-course assessment (March 17th) which includes a “live fire” element.**
- We specialize in providing USA Archery and NRA Instructor training to people interested in working with youth. A substantial discount has been applied for people affiliated with Boy Scouts or 4H. No youth affiliation please contact us to discuss class fees.
- **Refreshments and snacks will be provided, but please bring a bag lunch.**

Why the NRA:
