Why the NRA

Since its' founding in 1871, a major objective of the National Rifle Association has been to provide education and training in the safe and proper use of firearms.

Today, that objective is successfully being fulfilled through the NRA Basic Firearm Training Program.

To qualify as an NRA instructor, you must:

- Possess and demonstrate a solid background in firearm safety and shooting skills. These can be acquired through previous firearms training and/or previous shooting experience.
- Successfully complete the appropriate NRA Instructor Course and examination.
- Receive the endorsement of the NRA Training Counselor conducting your training.
- Submit your application with appropriate certification fee.

Membership in the National Rifle Association is not required but strongly recommended.

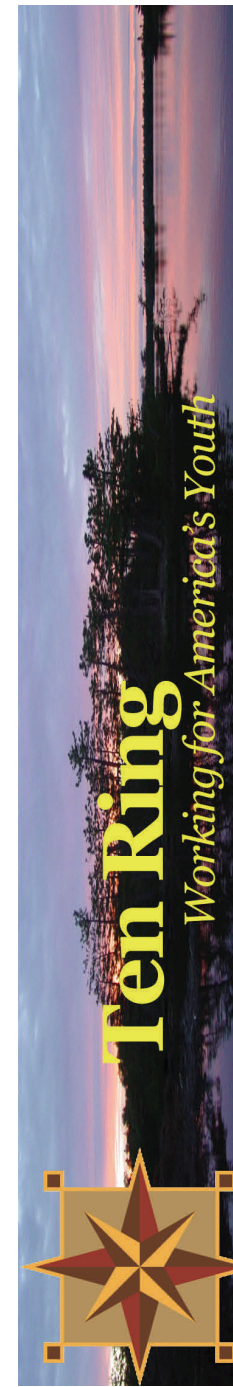
